We have also learnt a lot about the two athletes. She told us that to achieve what she did, she had to work hard: "you can do anything if you work hard" and also "you need to be supported by your family".

Linlin plays beach volleyball, she started in 2007 at the age of 16, now she is 28, is expecting but will resume her career after the birth of her 1st child. She said that beach volleyball is not easy, there are only two people playing and with the sand it's very difficult. She also participated in a lot of games. When she entered the sport life, she was supported by her family and she is proud of it.

As we can see, sport is a powerful tool, which shows us how men and women are equal. "Everyone has the right to do sports" and enjoy it!
