Dear Parents

The coronavirus epidemic originating in China requires everyone to be particularly vigilant, even if there is no reason to be overly worried. There are no suspected or confirmed cases in Vanuatu. The following indications are therefore given as a precaution.

Coronaviruses (CoV) are a large family of viruses generally responsible for colds and mild influenza-like illness. However, they can cause serious forms, especially in frail people (the elderly or those with chronic diseases, infants, pregnant women).

Symptoms are estimated to last between two days and two weeks maximum.

Steps to avoid the virus

- *Wash your hands regularly with soapy water or with alcohol – based washing solutions*
- *Avoid contact with live or dead animals, go to markets where animals are sold and avoid consuming undercooked or undercooked animal products*
- *Avoid close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection*

In the event of symptoms of respiratory infection (fever, cough, difficulty breathing), it is recommended to take the usual precautions so as not to contaminate those around:

- *isolate yourself, stay away,*
- *protect your mouth when coughing if necessary with a mask*
- *avoid touching your face (nose, hands, mouth)...*
- *use disposable tissues*
- *wash your hands regularly with soapy water or with alcohol-based washing solutions*
- *consult a doctor quickly.*

If your child has a fever and coughs, it is important to see a doctor quickly and keep him or her at home.

If you or one of your relatives has been in the Wuhan area or if you come from China, it is important to avoid contact with the school, children, parents and staff during 14 days before to be accepted to come back in the French school.
