CdG Meetings – February 2026

The 2025 annual accounts confirm that the school's financial position remains stable and well managed. The final net result for the year is consistent with previous years. This reflects careful financial management while maintaining the quality of education and preparing for the future.

The accounts are currently being audited. Once the audit is completed, they will be submitted for approval by parents at the General Assembly, which will take place in June 2026.

School Extension Project

The CdG continues to work with the school leadership and technical partners on the school extension project, aimed at improving and expanding learning spaces for students as the school continues to grow.

Current work focuses on project planning, feasibility studies, and initial design considerations. Further information will be shared with the community as the project progresses.
